If you capsize swim to the bank and get out of the water. If safe to do so, keep hold of boat and paddle and take them with you to the shore.

Cover cuts / wash hands before eating – Alcohol gel at race control.

If you bring a boat from another catchment ensure it is washed / dried out before and after the event to avoid transfer of invasive species.
