# 2. Purpose

# 3. General Selection Principles

- Competence Assessors: National Coaches and Team Management
- Selection Model: Combined points model (best 3 results from 4 races unless otherwise stated)
- Maximum Team Size: As specified per event.
- Funding: Limited team funding support; athlete contributions may apply
- **Definitions:** See Assessment Guidance Document for Definitions of <u>Developing, Moderate</u>, and <u>High</u> performance and competence levels
