

## **Selection for Junior and U23 European Championships 2022 Sprint and Classic**

**Target Event:** Junior and U23 World Championships 25<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> August  
**Target Venue:** Banja Luka, Bosnia

### **Event and Venue Assessment:**

Performance Level required for the Target Event has been designated: **Low**

Developing - Athletes should demonstrate a commitment to perform at an international standard and show the desire to improve. Achievement of good results is not the primary aim but wider objectives such as improving skills and experience is expected. Achievement of adequate international standard results is expected – as a guide, to finish within 15% of the class winner's time.

The Risk Level of the Target Venue has been designated: **Moderate**

Moderate - The venue may cause capsizes. In cases of capsizes, risk of loss or damage to equipment is possible though risk of personal injury is unlikely. Paddlers wishing to attend a Moderate risk event will need to have a competence assessment of Moderate or above

Competence assessment required: **Moderate**

**Estimated Team Contribution:** This trip will be supported by a team manager and coaches. It is expected the **team** contribution will be around but not limited to £750 per athlete.

## Selection for Senior World Championships 2022 Treignac, France

**Target Event:** Senior World Championships 2nd-5<sup>th</sup> June 2021  
**Target Venue:** Treignac France

### **Event and Venue Assessment:**

Performance Level required for the Target Event has been designated: **High**

High – Athletes should demonstrate a commitment to perform at their best. Achievement of high results is expected – as a guide, to finish in the Top Half in MK1 or equivalent % down on winner in other classes.

The Risk Level of the Target Venue has been designated: **High**

High - The venue may cause capsizes. In cases of capsizes, risk of loss or damage to equipment is likely and risk of personal injury is possible, Paddlers wishing to attend a high-risk event will need to have a competence assessment of High.

Competence assessment required: **High**

**Selection Events:** Classic 2<sup>nd</sup> April Tyrweryn Chapel Falls to below Bala Mill

In the event of no water release the event will be postponed to the 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> April and if this fails the Dee will be used on the 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> April

**Maximum Team per class:** 4 boats per class

**Estimated Team Contribution:** This trip will be supported by a team manager and coaches. It is expected the team contribution will be around but not limited to £750 per athlete.

## **Selection for Senior World Cup Celje Slovenia 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> June 2022**

**Target Event:** Senior World Cup 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> June 2022  
**Target Venue:** Celje, Slovenia

### **Event and Venue Assessment:**

Performance Level required for the Target Event has been designated: **Low**

Developing - Athletes should demonstrate a commitment to perform at an international standard and show the desire to improve. Achievement of good results is not the primary aim but wider objectives such as improving skills and experience is expected. Achievement of adequate international standard results is expected – as a guide, to finish within 15% of the class winner's time.

The Risk Level of the Target Venue has been designated: **Low**

Low – The venue is unlikely to cause capsizes. Risk of loss or damage to equipment is low and risk of personal injury is unlikely. Paddlers wishing to attend a Low risk event competition will need to have a competence assessment of Developing or above.

Competence assessment required: **Developing**

**Selection Event:** Classic 2nd April Tyrweryn Chapel Falls to below Bala Mill  
Sprint 3rd April Tyrweryn Chipper to below Ski Jump  
In the event of no water release the event will be postponed to the 9th-10th April and if this fails the Dee will be used on the 9th-10th April

**Selection Model:** Combined points model across Sprint and Classic races

**Maximum Team per class:** 4 boats per class

**Estimated Team Contribution:** This trip will be supported by a team manager and will be self-funded by the athletes
