

Barrow Races Series 2020-2021 Information

Race dates 3rd October, 14th November, 12th December, 16th January, 6th February, 6th March

Please read the event and Covid risk assessments regarding this race, a number of new measures are being put in place, it is important we comply with these to ensure we can continue to organise future events.

Organisation

The race is based from the Soar Bridge Inn, Barrow on Soar, Leicester,

The Start

There is a short paddler to the start along the canal, past the marina, followed by a short portage into the pool at the bottom of the weir.

The start is usually on the far bank river left.

The race is a time trial format with starts at 1 minutes intervals. You race against the clock down the river back to the Finish

The Finish

Is opposite the Boat House pub just below the Barrow on Soar road Bridge.

Paddlers are reminded to wait on the water for the next two competitors to finish before getting off the water.

You can exit the water from either bank.

Entries and Fees

Entries must be made online via the website www.wildwater.org.uk entries will close at 23.59 on the Thursday before each race.

Entries fees must be paid by bank transfer to our British canoeing account sort 20-63-33 Account 93316157 using In Notes or Payee Reference details

BAR5-2159 – And **Paddlers Initials** to the end of the reference. For the February race

BAR6-2159 – And **Paddlers Initials** to the end of the reference. For the March race

For example Zoe Smith would use BAR1-2159ZS for the October race and BAR4-2159ZS at the January race

During the entry process you will be asked to enter contact details that may need to be passed to Track and Trace.

Any driver or coaches should also complete the online form for track and trace purposes.

Entry fee will be £5 per paddler per race.

Late entries

Late entries will be accepted before 10.30am on the morning of each race, social distancing must be maintained.

Late entries will be added to the end of the startlist and given a number as they enter.

Payment will be by dropping you money in the container provided and no change will be given.

Start Lists

Startlists will be published online on the Friday before each event. No Startlists will be on display at the race venue

Race Numbers

No bibs will be issued for the event. Number must be clearly displayed on white sticker on the both sides of the front deck of the boat. Suitable vinyl labels can be purchase from [Amazon](#)

Briefing

Under normal conditions No briefing will take place, briefing notes will be published with the start lists. If conditions require that we call a briefing it will be held in small groups and everyone will be required to wear a face a mask.

Results.

Results will be processed as soon as possible and provisional results posted on Facebook, no printed copies will be available on site after the race. Any queries or protested must be raised at this time, 30 minutes will be allowed for this process after which time the result will be considered correct and final.

Prize Giving

No prize giving will take place and competitors are asked to leave the site as soon as practicable.

The Soar Bridge Inn

The Pub will be open as usual and we will be required to follow their social distancing rules. Food will be available after the race but it need to be ordered before hand, they will not have their usual buffet service running.
